1. Call to order- 4:01pm
2. Welcome and Introductions
3. New Business
  - a. Budget SY 24-25
    - i. Previous budget was presented to proposed February 2024, with projected budget for this current school year
      1. Projected enrollment was 809
      2. Weighted Student Formula (WSF) based on enrollment
      3. Carryover of 5%
  - b. Budget SY 25-26
    - i. Presentation of the Salaried Financial Plan, will be followed by Comprehensive plan in February 2025
      1. Projected enrollment = 829
        - a. Teaching staff increased by 2 (one 12-month teacher, one SpEd Deaf and Hard of Hearing teacher)
        - b. Office staff increased by 1
        - c. Library assistant position added
      2. WSF increased but may not necessarily account for inflation
      3. Carryover of 5% includes contingency should enrollment not reach projection
  - c. Motion to approve- consensus reached
4. New Business (continued)
  - a. Uniform Policy- Proposed Changes
    - i. History- original uniform policy implemented in 1998
    - ii. Purpose/Benefits
    - iii. Uniform Policy Proposal, to be effective SY 25-26
      1. Tops- standard uniform top; team/club shirt can be worn on Fridays; no midriff allowed (status quo)
      2. Bottoms- must fit properly at the waist; must be mid-thigh in length; can be of any color or pattern as long as there are no inappropriate graphics/imagery as described in Section 7
        - a. *Proposed change: Rips, cuts, or frays cannot be above mid-thigh, or cannot expose skin above the mid-thigh*
        - b. *All in consensus with this proposed change*
      3. Outerwear- sweaters/jackets can be of any color or pattern as long as there are no inappropriate graphics/imagery as described in Section 7; hoods on jackets are not allowed to be worn
